background.

If you provide unpaid help and support to a relative, partner, friend or neighbour who is in need of help because they are ill, frail, have a disability, mental illness or have a substance misuse then you are a carer and this leaflet may be of help to you. Carers can be of any age, gender or ethnic

Getting the right information and support could help you in your care giving role.

NHS Grampian will support you in your caring role by:

- Recognising and listening to you as a person providing care.
- Providing the opportunity to discuss your concerns about the person's illness and how it is affecting you.
- Informing you of services and support available in your area.

Carers information points

Aberdeen Royal Infirmary and Royal Cornhill Hospital have an information point where carers of any age can go for free confidential support. Information can also be provided about:

- Welfare and benefit entitlements.
- Sourcing breaks and respite care.
- Access to support groups.
- Access to training opportunities.
- Advice on local support for carers.
